

Daily Check

- Before starting your day and your equipment, Please conduct the daily checks as outlined in Owner's Operator manual. Not only do these quick and easy maintenance checks ensure long life of your machine, they are also opportunities to perform some preventive measures to avoid a possible failure.
- These should include the following:
 1. Greasing all grease points
 2. Checking engine oil level
 3. Checking Hydraulic oil level
 4. Check radiator coolant level
 5. Check radiator and oil cooler for damage and blockage
 6. Check transmission oil level
 7. Level of fuel (using fuel gauge)
 8. Inspect air cleaner and hoses
 9. Tires and wheels (tire pressure and wheel lug nut torque)
 10. Fan belt tension
- Before starting up the loader, verify safety functions work, which should include headlamps, rear lamp, control locks and any optional equipment (horn, back up alarm).

These items, and following your Owners / Operator manual will help ensure a full safe day of work.
